## **COL LARRY C. DEWEY**

COL Larry Dewey in 1990, while attending college for his undergraduate degree in education, enlisted in the Michigan Army National Guard as a Combat Engineer and was commissioned in 1994 as an ROTC Distinguished Military Graduate from Northern Michigan University. His first assignment was to the 95th Military Police Battalion in Mannheim, Germany where he served as a platoon leader in the 570th and 272d MP Companies and deployed in support of Operation Joint Endeavor in



the Balkans in 1996. He completed his tour in Europe as the Confinement Officer at the 9th Military Police Detachment, Sandhofen Germany. After completing the MP Officer Advanced Course in 1998, CPT Dewey commanded the Fort Greely Military Police Detachment in Alaska and served as the Provost Marshal for one of the Army's most remote installations.

CPT Dewey attended the John F. Kennedy Special Warfare Center in 2001, Fort Bragg, NC where he completed Civil Affairs, Regional Studies and German language courses and was assigned to D Company, 96th Civil Affairs Battalion (Airborne). Following a deployment to Operation Iraqi Freedom, Irbil, Iraq in April 2003, CPT Dewey transferred to F Company. From September 2004 to March 2005, MAJ Dewey deployed to Nairobi, Kenya as a Civil Affairs Team Leader and US Embassy Liaison Officer. MAJ Dewey and his team conducted Civil Affairs Operations in support of Combined Joint Task Force Horn of Africa. MAJ Dewey graduated from the US Army Command and General Staff College in 2006 and was assign to the 18th MP Brigade, Mannheim Germany as the Brigade Training Officer. While deployed to Baghdad, Iraq from September, 2007 to December, 2008, he served as the Police Transition Team Chief and advisor of the Baghdad Provincial Police Headquarters. While supporting Iraqi police operations and expansion, Major Dewey and his team established a new police training center for Baghdad Province, the largest law enforcement training center in Iraq, which recruited and trained over 1,000 new police officers per class.

MAJ Dewey served as the Provost Marshal Operations Officer, Training and Doctrine Command Headquarters from 2009 to 2011, Fort Monroe, Virginia. In June 2011, LT Dewey was assigned as the Deputy Brigade Commander, 8th Military Police Brigade, Schofield Barracks, Hawaii. He commanded the 19th Military Police Battalion (CID) from 2013 to 2015 which conducted felony investigations throughout Alaska, Hawaii, Korea, Japan and other areas where Soldiers are forward deployed throughout the Pacific Rim.

COL Dewey has commanded the 16th Military Police Brigade 20 July, 2017 at Fort Bragg, NC. In June, 2017 he graduated from the US Army War College. His last operational assignment was as the Deputy Director of the National Security Justice Development Directorate, Bagram Afghanistan from 2015 to 2016. Served as the senior Coalition Forces advisor to the Afghan National Army Military Police Command and Justice Center.
